# **TAANS Shoot Criteria**

## **OVERVIEW For Participants:**

**The TAANS Legacy shoot:** More than just a simple archery shoot. The annual TAANS Legacy shoot is a chance to highlight traditional archers and its community. It is a time to reconnect with old friends and of course make new ones. It is the easiest opportunity to ask questions regarding the sport if you are a newcomer. Or to share your own experience and knowledge if you are a regular.

**DATE:** The TAANS Legacy shoot is held on the second full weekend in July in Nova Scotia.

#### ABOUT THE TAANS LEGACY SHOOT:

- → Registration begins between 8:00 and 8:30AM. Start 9:00 AM. This shoot is two days long with two rounds each day. One in the morning, one in the afternoon. Split by lunch break.
- → Each round typically has twenty targets.
- → 2 arrows are shot per target.
- → Traditional equipment only.

### The TAANS Frolic(s):

Dates for the shoot are throughout the year. Time of registration, shoot days and rounds may be different.

## Scoring Divisions for all TAANS shoot events: M Male F Female

- → Longbow (M/F): For shooters shooting with a longbow (string doesn't touch limb when strung), no length requirement, no arrow material requirement.
- → Recurve (M/F): For shooters shooting with a recurve (string touches limbs when strung), no arrow material requirement.
- → **Primitive (M/F)**: For shooters shooting a wood bow (no glass no carbon), no arrow material requirement.
- → Horsebow (M/F): For shooters who are in horseback riding and Korean bow shooting.
- → Junior (M &F combined, all bows): For shooters age 12 and under age 18.
- → Cub (M &F combined, all bows): For shooters age 11 and under
- → Fun Class: For shooters of any age and style. Non-competitive. Shoot from a comfortable distance.



# Traditional Archers Association Nova Scotia

### Technical Requirements for all divisions and all TAANS shoot events:

- → Equipment must be traditional. No compound or crossbows are allowed.
- → Any type of arrow is permitted in all classes.
- → No sights, No range finders, No plunger, No adjustable arrow rest.

### Distances & Stakes (may differ for the TAANS Frolic):

- → The shooter may be within the 1 m box behind the shooting stake.
- → All targets will be unmarked distances.
- → Each target has two shooting positions except for stations with two targets. Stations with two targets can have one shooting position with one arrow per target.
- → Three stakes at each target. Two white and one different colour.

#### **TAANS Event Rules:**

- 1. Good sportsmanship will be the overarching standard. Unbecoming behaviour will be swiftly dealt with by TAANS executive.
- 2. No alcohol is permitted on the course, or the shooting range during the event.
- 3. No open fires unless permitted by the host.
- 4. Garbage and recycling is the responsibility of all those attending. Please use available facilities to dispose of things properly during the event.
- 5. When tearing down your campsite, use the rule of "Leave No Trace".

## **Novelty Shoots:**

At least one novelty shoot to be offered at the **TAANS Legacy shoot**.

## Grand Prix Shoot off for Overall TAANS Champion (only at the TAANS Legacy Shoot):

- → On Sunday after the second round there will be a shoot-off of the first-place shooter in each division (except for fun class).
- → Three targets will be arranged at varying unmarked distances.
